- Competition will be held on six contest areas from which four of them will have a video replay system. (If necessary, we will accommodate more contest areas).

KEYNOTES – KYORUGI:

- On-line application at www.tkd-reg.com
 - All competitors must have registered medical exam not older than six months in order to participate.
 - Complete "A" and "B" class: pioneers (8-9/10-11) will work on electronic „KPNP“ armors (provided by the organizer and electronic helmets) while the rest of the equipment for "A" and "B" class is provided by the competitors themselves (with electronic pedals, arm and leg protectors, suspensor, helmets).
 - Weigh-in tolerance for pioneers is 100 grams. If a contestant does not meet requirements for his division, he can switch to another for a fee of 30 eur.
 - There is no weigh-in tolerance for cadets, juniors and seniors.
 - Mandatory use of foot protectors.
 - For competitors in “B” class, kicks to the head are not allowed.
 - All competitors are considered to participate on their own risk and organizers are not responsible for any injury, or loss of equipment or documents.
 - Competitors younger than 18 must have written parental approval.
 - Coaches on contest areas are required to be of legal age and dressed in sportswear clothes and shoes.
 - Protest fee is 90 eur.
- "15. Zrenjanin OPEN 2026." for pioneers 10-11 "A" and "B" classes, cadets, juniors and seniors "A" and "B" classes, work will be done on the "KPNP" electronic scoring system that includes electronic helmets and electronic armor (everything is provided by the organizer) and slippers (can be provided by the competitors themselves, but the organizer also provides slippers).
- For all registered competitors, entry fee must be paid even if they do not show up on the competition.
 - Competitors in “B” class will provide all necessary protective equipment for competition themselves (body protector, helmet, teeth guard, forearm and lower leg protector and gloves)
 - All violations of the rules of conduct and ethics of sport will be sanctioned in accordance with the act and disciplinary code of TAS.

KEYNOTES – POOMSAE:

- Note: Competitions will be held only for recognized poomsae.
- No competitions in free style.
- Technical info: The competition is going to be held in TWO (2) classes: A class- black belts (1st DAN/Poom and higher) Except for children in A class (4th KUP and higher) B class - color belts (from 8th - 1st KUP).
- Scores will be given by 5 referees, with the exclusion of the highest and lowest marks in both accuracy and presentation marks. “A” Class - Categories and Rules

- Age divisions are based on year of birth.

Example: If someone is 17 years old on the day of the competition, but in the current year they are to turn 18, contestants will perform in the competition division - 18 to 30 years.

System of Competition "A" CLASS - Cut off system

1st round Preliminary: When 20 or more contestants are participating: Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and half from each group shall advance to the semi-final based on their points. In the preliminary round, each group might be judged by a different group of judges. If the number of contestants is odd, then the number is rounded to be an even number, e.g. if there are 13 contestants in the group, 13 contestants are considered as 14 contestants and 7 contestants shall advance to semi-final.

2nd round Semi-final: When 9 to 19 contestants are participating: The competition shall start from semi-final round. Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae and 8 of them shall advance to the final, on the basis of their points. 3rd round Final: When 8 or fewer contestants are participating: The competition shall start from the final round. Contestants shall perform two Poomsae, in accordance with the drawing of lots. Note: The organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of Poomsae to be performed in the preliminary and in semi-final round to 1 (one) form.

Procedure in case of equal score:

In case there is a tied score after the completion of the preliminary round, at the last place of the best 50%, respectively on the 8th rank of the semi-final round, the points in the presentation will be the determining factor for advancement to the next round. If this score is equal as well, all competitors in question will advance.

In case there is a tied score after the completion of the final round on the rank 1, 2, or 3, the contestant who is awarded more points in the presentation shall be declared as a winner. In case the score is still tied, the contestant who has more total points (including highest and lowest) shall be the winner. If the score is tied after the addition of the total points, competitors shall have a rematch. The referee will decide about the Poomsae to be performed (in any case it will be one of the compulsory Poomsae).

KICK

The Kick discipline is intended for competitors in the following age categories:

Categories: Children 6-7 years old Children 8-9 years old Children 10-11 years old Cadets Juniors
There are no weight categories in this discipline, and boys and girls compete together within their respective age categories. The winner is determined after winning two rounds. In case of a tie, an additional third round will be held.

Competition Rules: After each executed kick, the foot must touch the ground before performing the next kick. It is not allowed to touch the punching bag with hands. Competitors who do not follow the rules will be disqualified.

Coaches are required to be of legal age and dressed in sportswear clothes and shoes.

**Note: There are no weight categories of gender divisions.
Boys and girls are compete together.**
