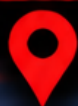

COMPETITION RULES - KYORUGI

- Submit online applications at www.tkd-reg.com.
- All competitors registered for the current year may compete if their medical examination is not older than 6 months.
- Weight tolerance for children is 100 grams. There is no weight tolerance for cadets, juniors and seniors.
- If a competitor does not match the registered weight, a fee of 10 EUR must be paid to change the weight category.
- Foot protectors are required for all competitors.
- For B class competitors, head kicks are not allowed.
- All competitors compete at their own risk. The organizer accepts no responsibility for injuries or loss of personal belongings.
- Competitors under 18 must have a permit signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- Protest fee: 50 EUR.
- The organizer provides electronic KPNP head guards and chest protectors.
- Competitors must provide their own KPNP electronic foot protectors.
- The organizer provides head guards with face masks for children and cadets (A and B class).
- In case of a lost ID, a coach may request a temporary ID for a fee of 10 EUR.

All registered competitors are required to pay the registration fee, even if they do not attend.

POOMSAE COMPETITION

COMPETITION CLASSES AND FORMAT

The competition will be held in TWO classes:

- A class: black belts, except Pioneers 1 (4th KUP and higher).
- B class: color-belt grades (8th to 1st KUP).

For A class - individual, pairs and teams - a Single Elimination Tournament System will be used, as in Kyorugi. Two competitors perform a form simultaneously. The software/computer announces the forms immediately before the athletes perform, so the form draw will not be published one day in advance.

A-class categories with only one competitor, as well as the complete B class, will follow the previous Cut-Off System.

- The B-class form program for all age divisions is given in the tables; forms are selected.
- Performances are scored by five judges, with the highest and lowest scores excluded.
- In all A- and B-class categories, the uniform must correspond to the athlete's belt and grade. A competitor wearing a colored belt may not wear a dobok with a black collar. In such a case, 0.3 points will be deducted before the performance, or the competitor may cover the collar with white tape.

COMPETITION RULES - POOMSAE

CUT-OFF SYSTEM

- Preliminary: When 20 or more competitors participate, each athlete performs two compulsory forms. Half of each group advances to the semi-final according to points. If the number of competitors is odd, it is rounded up to an even number.
- Semi-final: With 9-19 competitors, the competition starts from the semi-final. Competitors perform two compulsory forms and the top eight advance to the final.
- Final: With eight or fewer competitors, the competition starts from the final round. Each competitor performs two compulsory forms. The top four competitors/pairs/teams are awarded; third and fourth place receive bronze medals.
- If there is a large number of competitors or insufficient time, the organizer may, in agreement with the technical commission, change the A-class qualification format so that one compulsory form is performed instead of two in each round. In B class, competitors perform one selected form in each round.

DECISION AND DECLARATION OF THE WINNER

The winner is the competitor with the highest score. In case of a tie, the competitor with more presentation points wins. If still tied, the higher total of all judges' scores, including the previously excluded highest and lowest marks, decides the winner. If the result remains tied, an additional match is held using one compulsory form selected by the judges; the previous result does not affect the rematch. If the rematch is tied, the higher total including the lowest and highest marks decides the winner.

FREESTYLE POOMSAE RULES

The performance is based on Taekwondo techniques combined with music and choreography.

- The Yeon-mu line is selected by the competitor.
- Music and choreography are selected by the competitor.
- The performance must remain within the boundaries of Taekwondo technique.
- Freestyle Poomsae must include the compulsory elements. Any missing compulsory element will not be scored.

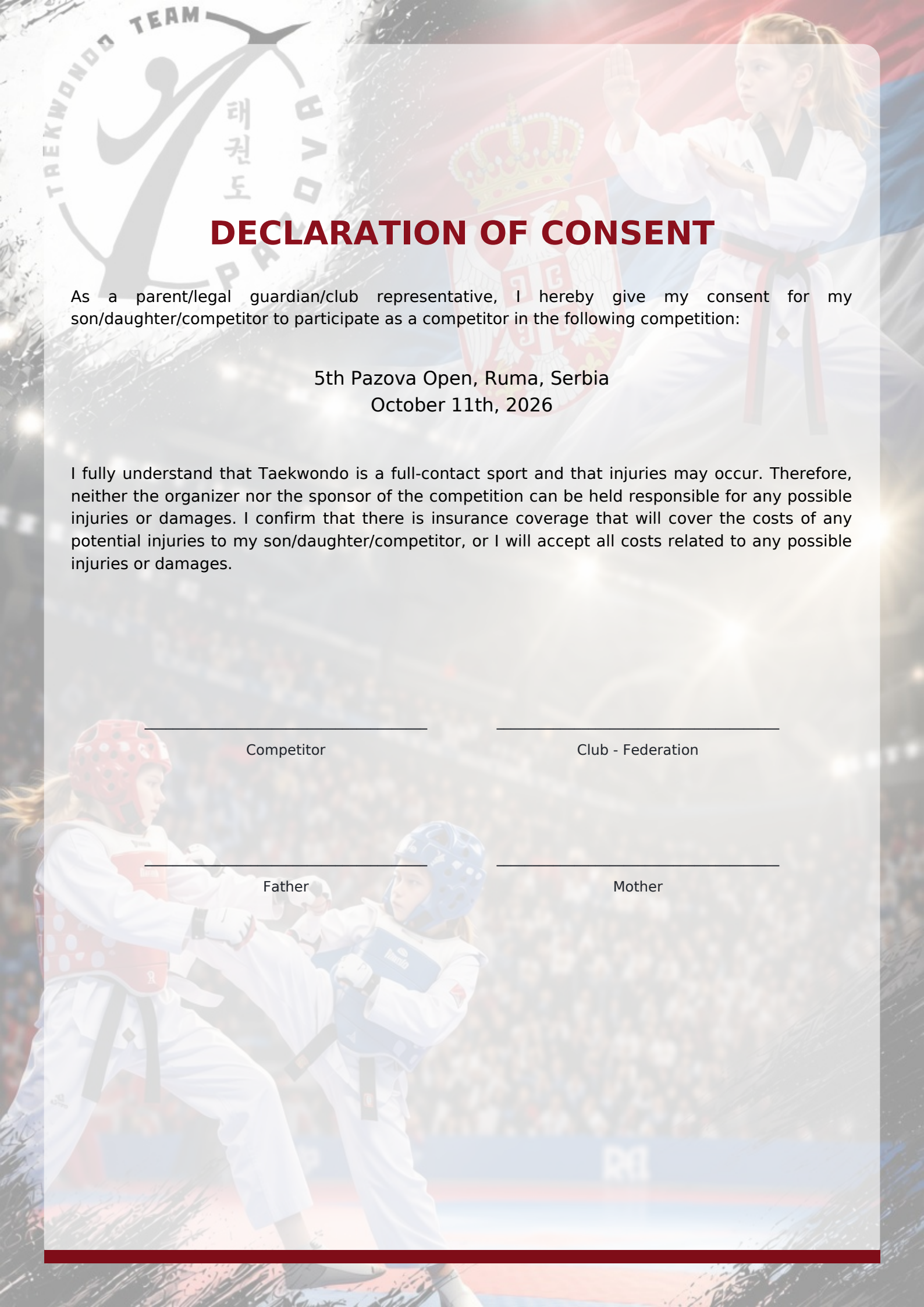

There are no weight categories or gender divisions in this discipline; boys and girls compete together. The draw and competition principles are the same as in sparring.

Required equipment: dobok and belt. The Zemita scoring system will be used. Electronic foot protectors are not required.

Awards: first, second and third place winners receive medals and diplomas.
